

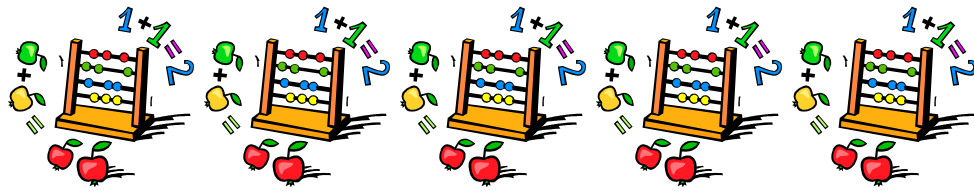
Subtracting Two Digit Numbers without Regrouping Game

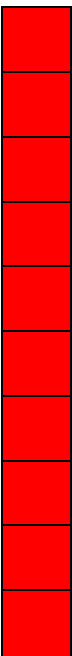

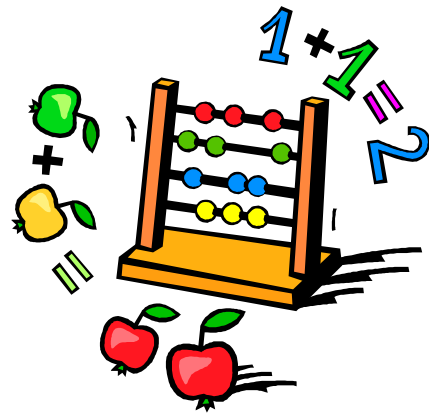
