

Run of the questions and put them into a box so your child can pull a question out and answer them.

*Where is the front of the book?

*Where is the back of the book?

*What is an author? (The person who writes the book.)

- *Who is the author of this book?
- *What does an illustrator do for a book? (They draw the pictures.)
- *Who is the illustrator of this book?
- *Show me where I read on this page? (Player points to the words not the picture.)
- *Point to where I should start reading on this page. (Player points to the first word of the first sentence.)

*Show me which way I go to read on this page. (Start at the beginning of the sentence and then point to the words left to right.)

*When I get to the end of the line of words on this page where do I go to keep reading?

*Point to each word as I read this page. (Player points to each word one by one.)

*Where is the first part of the book? Where is the last part of the book?

*Show me the bottom of this picture.

*Can I read the page like this? (Alter the line order so you read the bottom line first; it should NOT make sense.)

*Can I read this page (point to the page to the right) before I read this page (point to the page to the left)?

*Is this what the page reads? (Change the word order; the sentence should NOT sound right.)

*What does this mean (?)? (It is a question mark.)

*What does this mean (.)? (It is a period and that means you stop at the end of a sentence.)

*What does this mean (,)? (It is a comma and you pause when reading.)

*Show me a capital M and a small m (Ask to find a capital letter on the page and a small letter, it does not have to be an "Mm").

*Find the word _____. (Ask to find a specific word on that page.)

*With your fingers show me two letters.

*With your fingers show me one word.

*With your fingers show me the first letter of a word.

*With your fingers show me the last letter of a word.

*With your fingers show me a Capital letter.
